### **Dormitory and Related Information**

#### 1. Dormitory

A. Accommodation is provided during the study in the joint education program. The student pays the fees for this in accordance with the established procedure.

#### 2. International student insurance (mandatory)

- A. International students, like other foreigners, will be enrolled Insurance
- B. International students admitted to joint programs are required to enroll in the international student insurance, which will be introduced during orientation.
- C. Those who are enrolled in the insurance should submit their insurance certificate during orientation.

#### 3. Visa issuance for residents in Uzbekistan and abroad

A. Residents in Uzbekistan: Visa change application by Samarkand State University for admitted applicants

\* Students scheduled to travel abroad after the announcement of admitted applicants should notify the Center of International Education Programs in advance.

- B. Residents abroad
- Visa issuance documents (sent individually to admitted applicants): Certificate of Admission of University, tuition payment certificate, etc.
- Visa issuance: Submit the visa documents issued by University and additional documents requested by the Embassy or Consulate abroad (prepared individually by admitted applicants) to apply for a visa.
- Since additional documents required for visa issuance may vary by the Embassy or Consulate of each country, admitted applicants must confirm with the Embassy or Consulate in their own country.

\* If you are unable to obtain a visa to continue your studies in a country other than Uzbekistan for the next years, arrangements will be made to provide you with the opportunity to complete the program.

#### 4. Graduation requirements

- A. Students who successfully and fully completed their studies in a joint education program, in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, are awarded a bachelor's degree and are issued two documents on education.
- B. Each department has its own conditions for graduation, so admitted applicants must confirm with their respective department office.

## Important Notes for Applicants

- 01. All documents must be submitted in their original form. However, if unavoidable, copies may be used during the document screening process, but admitted applicants must submit the original documents to the International Student Admissions Team before final registration.
- 02. Documents not written in English must be submitted with a notarized translation into English. (e.g., diploma, certificate of completion, transcript, family certificate, etc.)
- 03. Candidates who are expected to graduate must submit their final graduation (completion) certificate to the Center of International Education Programs Team before admission.
- 04. After acceptance, an academic background check will be conducted on the applicant's final school based on the 'Academic Records Verification' form submitted by the applicant. Admission may be canceled if there is no response.
- 05. Additional documents may be requested if the submitted documents (original and notarized documents) are incomplete or if their authenticity needs to be verified.
- 06. All responsibilities for errors in the application or submitted documents, omissions, or unreadable entries lie with the applicant, and the details in the submitted documents cannot be changed or canceled.
- 07. If it is discovered that the admission was obtained through false information in the application or submitted documents (including translations) or through forgery or other fraudulent methods, the admission will be canceled, and if a student is already enrolled, their admission will be revoked if it is found they were admitted through fraudulent methods.
- 08. If the applicant's name differs on the submitted documents, a certificate proving the identity from the respective country's court must be attached.
- 09. Dual enrollment is prohibited: Once final acceptance is confirmed and registration is complete, the applicant cannot apply to other universities or different admissions processes at University as per the law. Violation of this may result in cancellation of acceptance and admission at all universities.
- 10. If you fail to enter the country by the 1/4 point of the semester days for the Fall semester of the academic year, your admission may automatically be canceled.
- 11. You must provide a contactable phone number during the admission process and notify the Center of International Education Programs Team if there are any changes. Any disadvantages arising from incorrect contact information or inability to contact the applicant are the responsibility of the applicant.
